COURSE OBJECTIVES

To introduce young instrumentalists to orchestral and ensemble playing, and to afford them the opportunity of meeting and living with others of their own age from all parts of the Education Authority, North Eastern area in a truly communal and integrated atmosphere..



STAFFING

The course will be supervised by the Authority's Instrumental Tutors and Pastoral staff, all of whom have Safeguarding Children Training. A nurse will be in attendance throughout the course and some of the staff are First Aid Trained. The decision of the Course Director will be final in all matters.

ELIGIBILITY

The course is open to all pupils at present in **P6, P7 or Yr 8** who have at least one year's experience of playing orchestral instruments (including orchestral percussion, but excluding recorder and piano).

REGISTRATION

1. Registration is available via an on-line form. Either phone 02894 482235 or email musicservice.antrim@eani.org.uk to request the link.
2. **The fee for the course will be £150 for the first child and £120 for any additional children.**
3. **Registrations should be returned by Friday 21st April 2023. On receipt of completed registration forms, the Music Service Office will make contact to take a £40 per child deposit.** Any applications received after this date will not be guaranteed a place on the course but will be held on a reserve list.
4. Successful applicants will be notified as soon as possible after this date.
5. Details of balance payment will be issued at a later date.
6. Places are limited and the Course Director reserves the right to take any appropriate action to ensure a correct instrumental balance.
