St Brigid's Primary School, Tirkane/Bunscoil Naomh Bríd is currently the only primary school in the North Eastern Region with an Irish Medium Unit. Where the school has a greater number of applicants than places available in either sector, it will apply its admissions criteria as set out below to decide which applicants to admit up to the quota stated.

Details of the respective functions of the Board of Governors and the Principal in relation to admission to the school.

The Board of Governors has empowered the Admissions Sub-committee to select pupils for admission, in addition to speaking with potential pupils and/or parents/guardians to assist the members in making decisions regarding admissions. The Admissions Sub-committee and the Principal will apply the admissions criteria. The Sub-committee is made up of the Principal and three other Governors.

Only children of compulsory school age will be admitted. Priority will be given in the application of each criterion to children regarded by the Board of Governors, on the basis of supporting evidence from parents/guardians and/or Statutory agencies, as having special circumstances, (i.e. medical, social, security) which would make it desirable that the applicant attends this school rather than another school.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria <u>punctual applications</u> will be considered before <u>late applications</u> are considered. The application procedure opens on 7 January 2021 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 29 January 2021 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a <u>punctual application</u>. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 29 January 2021 will be treated as a <u>late application</u>.

Admissions criteria to be used in the event of the school being oversubscribed. The criteria are listed in order of priority.

The following criteria will be applied in the **order set down** by the Board of Governors of St Brigid's Primary School, Tirkane in selecting children for admission to Primary 1 in September 2021:

- 1. Children who reside in the historical catchment area of the school, which encompasses both the parishes of Maghera and Granaghan.
- 2. Children who have a brother/sister (including half, step or foster brother/sister) currently enrolled in the school
- Oldest child in the family (or second oldest where the oldest attends a special school).
- 4. Children whose parent/guardian, brother/sister (including half, step or foster brother/sister) are former pupils of the school.
- 5. Children whose parent/guardian is a member of the full-time or part-time staff of the school.
- 6. Children will be admitted in chronological order (eldest first).

In the event of two children having the same date of birth the remaining place will be awarded on the basis of initial letter of the first forename as recorded on the child's birth certificate:

(This order is determined by a randomised selection of letters)

DUTY TO VERIFY

When considering which children should be selected for admission, the Board of Governors will <u>only</u> take into account information which is detailed on or attached to the application. Parents should therefore ensure that **all** information pertaining to their child and relevant to the school's admissions criteria is stated on the application or attached to it.

A copy of your child's birth certificate and all other documentation submitted in support of your application should be **uploaded as part of your application**.

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any application form.

The Board of Governors therefore require parents to provide a copy of two original documents:

- A letter from the Child Benefit office which clearly identifies the current address of the child at the time of application or another letter relating to this benefit and
- either a Utility Bill (electricity, gas, television licence, telephone) or rental agreement or Land and Property Services Rates demand or a financial statement from a bank or building society

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors as part of the application, this may result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

- 4. Children whose older brother/sister (including half, step or foster brother/sister) previously attended the school.
- 5. Children whose parent/guardian is a member of the full-time or part-time staff of the school.
- 6. Other children of compulsory school age on the basis of the order of dates of birth (eldest first).

In the event of two children having the same date of birth the remaining place will be awarded on the basis of initial letter of first forename as recorded on child's birth certificate.
